# Scrum Values



#### **Openness**

The Scrum Team and its stakeholders agree to be open about all the work and the challenges with performing the work



#### Commitment

People personally commit to achieving the goals of the Scrum Team





#### **Focus**

Everyone focuses on the work of the Sprint and the goals of the Scrum Team



#### Courage

Scrum Team members have courage to do the right thing and work on tough problems




#### Respect

Scrum Team members respect each other to be capable, independent people



# The Three Pillars of Empiricism





#### Product owner

Responsible for the *product backlog* (team's understanding, completeness), works towards maximizing the *value of the final product*.

## The role

#### **Development team**

Responsible for the resulting *increments* in each sprint. It is *self-organized, cross-functional and specialized*, with 3 to 9 members.

#### **Scrum master**

Responsible for *Scrum implementation, understanding and adherence*. It is an *assistance* role, rather than a managerial one.



## The role

#### What makes a Scrum Master good in their role is that they...

- Ensure adherence to Scrum framework by all Team Members (including PO).
- Promote an ideal project environment for the Scrum Team to have successful sprints.
- Oversee Sprint Planning Sessions and convene other meetings.
- Act as a servant-leader that motivates and coaches the team.
- Help the team overcome blockers by helping to find assistance and available resources.
- Coach the team to self-organize and work towards getting the job done.

#### Is not a Project Manager because

 A project manager is a traditional management role that ensures work is done from a position of control, whereas a Scrum Master is a servant leader that coaches the team.

#### Is not a Secretary because

 Secretaries take care of routine administrative functions and help their employer manage the day-to-day operations. Because Scrum Teams are self-organized, they do not need a secretary.



### The role

#### **Common problems with SCRUM teams**

- The team members do not keep the dashboard updated
- The team members do not create the subtasks needed
- When the scrum master is acting as Product Owner (PO)
- Not respecting time boxes previously defined for the sprints
- All team members have to agree on the definition of DONE
- Ceremonies are not handled correctly
- Excessive meetings are held during the sprint
- The team starts working on stories that do not comply with definition of ready lack of acceptance criteria, lack of requirement definitions
